**ORDINANCE AMENDING LAKETOWN TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NUMBER 2020-02 ENTITLED
“REGULATING OWNERSHIP, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC SEWER SYSTEMS”**

The following is a summary of An Ordinance Amending Laketown Township Ordinance 2020-02, requiring additional pumping at owner’s expense when prohibited discharges are discovered outside of the regular inspection and pumping schedule, passed at the June 26, 2023 Laketown Town Board Meeting. The full text of the ordinance is available for inspection during regular office hours at the office of the Town Clerk in the Laketown Township Hall and is also posted on the Laketown Township website: www.laketowntownship.info. This Ordinance revises Laketown Ordinance No. 2020-02, and sets forth standards:

- Requires property owners to be responsible for the cost of pumping the septic tank when additional pumping is required outside of regular inspection and pumping schedule (36 months) and a prohibited discharge is found.
- Where a prohibited discharge is found, property owner’s septic tank will be pumped annually until two consecutive times result in no prohibited discharge found.
- Requires property owner to be responsible for two times the cost of annual pumping if prohibited discharge is found.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication in the official Township newspaper.
